Plastic - transported to Jayplas in South Normanton for separation. It then goes to Corby or Loughborough for granulating to be sold.

Paper/card - this goes to D.S.Smith to their plant in Sittingbourne in Kent. There it is made into board and boxes for packaging.

There are lots of groups in the villages with their own desires but one thing they all have in common is the need for a centre of some description to do things in. Carlton have the Village Hall but Camblesforth close by are having to use the Methodist Chapel which is a little tired inside.

Help may be at hand from some developers but sadly the application for 80 homes was turned down. This would have provided a village green and car park close by the chapel with some funding towards bringing the building into the 21st century.

Moving to Hemingbrough and a group there have been set up to look at providing the village with its own purpose built building for community use. Again the parish have to rely, at present, on the local chapel. The project is in its infancy and it has my support.

Carlton - The village will be getting more new homes and as a consequence, funding for the repair to the Village Hall, improvements to the Cricket Club infrastructure and a new pedestrian crossing near the High School. The new homes will also help sustain the local shops and pubs.
